June 1st, John 15:26-16:4

Jesus Speaks to the Disciples

²⁶ "But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness about me. ²⁷ And you also will bear witness, because you have been with me from the beginning."

June 8th, John 14:23-31

Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. 28 You heard me say to you, 'I am going away, and I will come to you.' If you loved me, you would have rejoiced, because I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I. 29 And now I have told you before it takes place, so that when it does take place you may believe. 30 I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming. He has no claim on me, 31 but I do as the Father has commanded me, so that the world may know that I love the Father. Rise, let us go from here.



PRAYING FOR PEACE

Peace negotiations are a frequent topic in world news these days. Strife and warfare between nations and people groups is nothing new. Nevertheless, we continue to pray that the Prince of Peace Himself would hinder the hands raised to inflict violence and cool the hearts enraged with wrath, that reasonable settlements might be reached to stop the bloodshed, restore order, and bring lasting peace. We can be certain that this prayer is heard, and we ought to pray it in all boldness and confidence.

Jesus is the Prince of Peace (Isaiah 9:6) and He is pleased to hear our prayers for peace and yet, He is also the one who tells us, "I have not come to bring peace, but a sword" (Matt. 10:34), What are we to make of this?

As always, the problem lies with us and not Jesus. Jesus really is the Prince of Peace. That means that He rules over peace. Peace answers to Him. Peace goes where its Prince sends it. We do not negotiate terms for peace with Jesus. We either receive the peace that He freely gives, or we don't. And when we will not have His peace, we will have instead the "sword" of fighting and squabbling, violence and bloodshed. We are the ones who take up arms daily against Him with our sin even though He is ever ready to pour out upon us His peace.

Peace, all peace, begins and ends with Jesus suffering, dying and rising again from the dead. So, Jesus tells His disciples after His resurrection: "Thus it is written, that the Christ should suffer and on the third day rise from the dead, and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins should be proclaimed in his name to all nations, beginning from Jerusalem" (Lk 24:46047).

Keep praying boldly and confidently for peace, remembering that peace begins with repentance and is delivered with the forgiveness of sins. You don't get to negotiate with Jesus for it, you can simply receive His peace. Consider also how Jesus told His first disciples that His peace mission would begin for them in Jerusalem. Jerusalem was their home turf. It was to begin with them in their own lives in their own homes. So it remains today.

Keep praying for peace everywhere around the world. Expect Jesus to answer your prayer. And look for His answer first in your own heart as He delivers His peace by putting you on your knees in repentance for your ongoing warfare of sin against Him.

As you pray for peace, I commend to you the following prayer from page 314 of the Lutheran Service Book (the maroon hymnals):

Heavenly Father, God of all concord, it is Your gracious will that Your children on earth live together in harmony and peace. Defeat the plans of all those who would stir up violence and strife, destroy the weapons of those who delight in war and bloodshed, and, according to Your will, end all conflicts in the world. Teach us to examine our hearts that we may recognize our own inclination toward envy, malice, hatred, and enmity. Help us, by Your Word and Spirit, to search our hearts and to root out the evil that would lead to strife and discord, so that in our lives we may be at peace with all people. Fill us with zeal for the work of Your Church and the proclamation of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, which alone can bring that peace which is beyond all understanding, through Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.




June 26 – 29 – National Convention – Growing in God's Grace (2 Peter 3: 18) in Omaha. Nebraska



CHRIST'S HANDS IN ACTION - Do you have tasks or small jobs around the house with which you need help? 
